The volumes of the series "Lives Remembered" can be ordered from the National Fund.

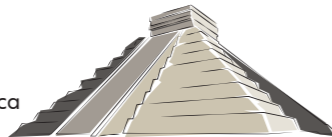

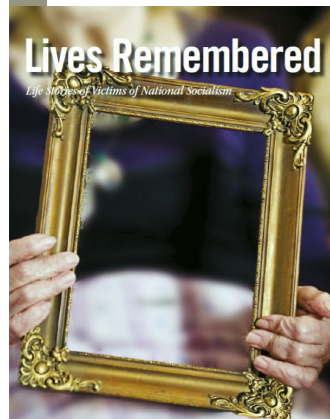

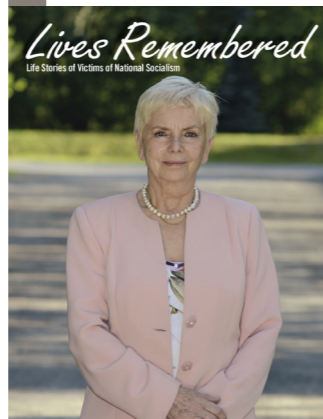




Volume 1
"Groups of Victims"

The English edition of volume 1 of the series, "Lives Remembered. Life Stories of Victims of National Socialism" contains 33 life stories spanning 270 pages, in which victims of National Socialism from various groups of victims tell their stories of persecution. A guest contribution on the various autobiographical materials by the German scholar Manfred Müller introduces the volume.

"1942"

Volume 2 of the series "Lives Remembered" is a bilingual turnover book containing 30 autobiographical testimonies of survivors in German and English spanning 336 pages. By way of introduction, the life stories are preceded by a contribution by the historian Gerhard Botz on the pivotal historical events of 1942.



Volume 3
"Exile in Africa"

Across 240 pages, volume 3 of the series "Lives Remembered", subtitled "Exile in Africa", documents in English and German language the life stories of nine people who found themselves in African countries during their flight from the Nazis. The book also contains a contribution by the historian Albert Lichtblau, who has conducted a great many interviews – also in Africa – with Holocaust survivors himself.



Volume 4 /1-3
"Exile in Asia"

Volume 4 of the series "Lives Remembered" spans over 1,000 pages (in three parts) dealing with the subject of exile in Asia. It contains 23 stories, in German and English, of people whose flight from the Nazis took them briefly or permanently to Asian countries. A guest contribution by the historian Margit Franz illuminates the special situation in Asia and the political (colonial) and cultural backgrounds.
